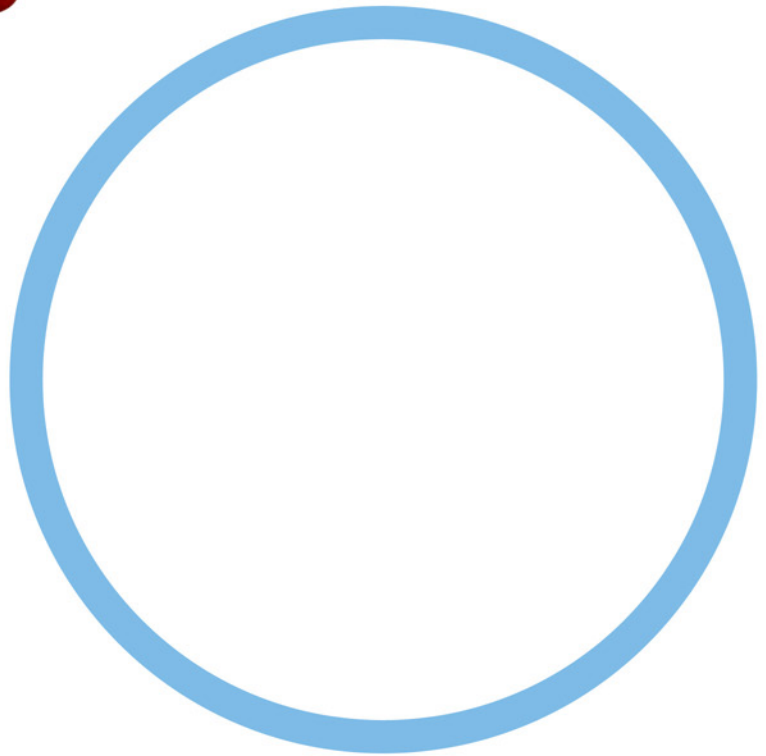


peek-eebee



Babies LOVE looking through holes to get a special view of the world! Use this simple “peek-eebee” game “frame” to play some interactive language skill-building games.



1. Fold this sheet in half to easily cut out the circle.
2. Look through the hole at your child. Say hello. Wiggle your fingers through the hole.
3. Move the paper around so that it frames different parts of your face. Stick your nose through the hole....“Sniff, sniff...I smell you.”
4. Center your mouth in the hole. Speak to your baby. Stick out your tongue. Have fun.
5. Move the paper around your child’s face, too. Touch and name and describe his/her features
6. As a “baby reading” activity, lay the paper over a page in a picture book or magazine. Move it around and describe what you see through the hole.
